The three-week Dallas GPA, which has occurred on the campus of Dallas Theological Seminary annually since 2005, is a once-in-a-lifetime educational and networking experience for 25-27 of the world's finest young pastors.

Details about hosting a pastor are below.

Pick up:

Pastors will be ready for pick up at 10:00 a.m. Saturdays from the Dallas Theological Seminary campus security kiosk (located in the visitor parking lot on Apple Street). Your pastor will have eaten breakfast prior to pick up.
